Letters, journals, speeches, newspaper columns, diaries, meditations, and a fable (Rachel Carson's introduction to *Silent Spring*) also find places in this room. Such unconventional documents challenge traditional notions of invention, arrangement, style, and delivery, and blur the boundaries between public and private discourse. Included, too, are writers whose voices have not been heard in any tradition. Ritchie and Ronald seek to "unsettle" as they expand the women's rhetorical canon. Arranged chronologically, *Available Means* is designed as a classroom text that will allow
