The purpose of this study was to determine if a differentiated approach to reading instruction would affect the literacy development of emergent readers. The six week study was conducted in a Title I classroom with a group of four first grade students. The literacy instruction was designed using a framework developed by Beverly Tyner. The students' reading behaviors were observed at point of error and when self correcting. Through daily charting logs, weekly teacher journaling and pre and post assessments I was able to illustrate literacy development. One student made little growth, two showed good growth the fourth student made accelerated growth.

The goal of this book is to answer the question What is differentiated instruction? It offers pre-service and in-service teachers the background and foundational skills they will need to understand, plan for, and achieve effective differentiated literacy instruction in their classrooms, based on individual student needs. Chapters provide essential information about how to analyze and synthesize data from assessments, use the information for grouping students, and then plan and implement differentiated instruction. Many specific, hands-on descriptions and exhibits are provided. Case studies of real classrooms demonstrate effective differentiated instructional techniques.
