Using 30 dog-owner pairs, researchers focused on a communicative behavior called showing, in which dogs gather the attention of a communicative partner and direct it to an external source.

Her behavior speaks volumes about the relationship between dog and human and the general personality of her owner. Calm vs. hyper: Owners of calm dogs are perceived as organized and in control. Separation anxiety is one of the most commonly discussed dog behavior problems. Manifestations include vocalization, chewing, inappropriate urination and defecation, and other forms of destruction that occur when a dog is separated from his owner. The same dog-owner interaction (DOI) subscale has been shown to be positively affected by the owners training engagement and negatively by the dog's aggressive/unfriendly behavior and excessive barking (both as perceived by the owner), owner age, number of people in the household, and dog age and size (Bennett and Rohlf, 2007).
